The Judicial and Legal Services Commission is established under section 110E of the Belize Constitution. The members of the Judicial and Legal Services Commission are appointed by the Governor-General and comprise of:-

- The Chairman of the Public Services Commission, as Chairman
- The Chief Justice
- The Solicitor General
- The President of the Bar Association of Belize.

“Judicial and Legal Services” means services in the Departments of Offices of the General Registry of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeal, Magistracy, Chief Parliamentary Counsel, Law Revision, Family Court, Intellectual Property, Corporate Affairs and Companies, Director of the Public Prosecutions and Solicitor General.

The powers of the Judicial and Legal Services are listed below:

1. Appointment & Confirmation
2. Transfer
3. Promotion
4. Removal from office
 - i. Dismissal
 - ii. Retirement
 - iii. Termination
5. Discipline
6. Conditions of service.
7. Review the suitability of applicants.

The Judicial and Legal Services Commission may, by directions in writing and subject to such conditions as it thinks fit, delegate any of its powers under subsection 110F(1) to any one or more members of the Judicial and Legal Services Commission or, with the consent of the Prime Minister, to any public officer who is a judicial or legal officer.
